Around the world, 2 billion people don't have access to clean water



2 billion people do not have a simple toilet



Why do we need clean water?



What happens when people don't have access to clean water and toilets?



Health Impact: people get sick from drinking and bathing in dirty water



Physical Impact: Women and girls carry 5 gallons of water for about 5 kilometers, 3 to 5 times a day



Educational Impact: Girls cannot go to school because they are carrying water.



Economic Impact: Women cannot have a job and earn an income.



What's the solution?

Water1st works to provide clean water systems + toilets for people living in Honduras, Bangladesh, Ethiopia, and Mozambique

We work WITH people so that they are empowered to break their own cycle of poverty.






Our projects are a permanent solution. Each member of the community has clean water and a toilet FOR LIFE.

Instead of carrying water, girls can go to school




Instead of carrying water, women have time to start a business, earn an income
